EDITING ASSIGNMENT

The final project maybe done individually or in a group. A group project will require +2 minutes per additional student. So, if you had three people, your project would need to be 9 – 11 minutes in length.

Items for this assignment include:

- Pitch (due 6/30)
- Papercut/Storyboard (digital (printed screenshot) or analog) (due 07/07)
- Rough Cut uploaded to YouTube – max 10 minutes (due 07/14)
- Final Cut (due 7/28)

Each completed project should be 5 - 7 minutes in length and include the following:

- Original or Acquired Footage
- At least one still image
- Multiple audio tracks to including music
- Title Credits
- White Balance
- Audio Sweetening – levels
- At least two different transition types
- At least one added video effect
- Submit on DVD (directions to follow)

The final project will be 60% of your final grade. However, the final project is divided into multiple smaller projects. The grading for the final project will be as follows:

Pitch	20% 60 points
Papercut/Storyboard	20% 60 points
Rough Cut	30% 90 points
Final Cut	40% 120 points

Each day an assignment is late, it drops 10% or one letter grade of its worth. Students must attend class and present for the pitch and rough cut. If you will be gone on either of these dates, it must be cleared with the instructor at least one class period prior to the presentation date.

It is the student's responsibility to back up all materials, so if a hard drive fails the project is not lost. All students must have external hard drives to store the project on.

If students need help generating ideas for the project, or would like to work on an existing external project, please speak with the instructor before next week.
